For abbreviations of journal titles, use the **World List of Scientific Periodicals**. Publication charges are \$20.00 for each page of printed material, \$20.00 for each page of tabulated material and \$5.00 for each extra illustration up to one-half page in size. The charge for each extra full-page illustration is \$10.00. Charges for reprints depend upon the number of pages the article contains and the number of copies ordered. A reprint charge schedule and order form is mailed to authors at or about the time they receive the page proofs.
